SCHOLARSHIP NOTIFICATION

National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) for 2018-19: Inviting applications from class 10th Students

All those eligible students studying in class 10th in any Government/Private Schools/Kendriya/Navodya Vidhyalyas or other school recognized/affiliated with JKBOSE or CBSE are informed that the National Council of Education, Research & Training (NCERT), New Delhi through the Jammu and Kashmir State Board of School Education is going to conduct State level National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) for Session 2018-19 (Stage-I) on 4th November 2018 (Sunday). Those who are selected/recommended from Stage-I examination, will be eligible to appear for Stage-II examination to be conducted by NCERT on 12th May 2019 (Sunday). Applicant must have secured 60% marks (5% relaxation for ST/SC category) in class 9th and due for appearing in ensuing class 10th Annual Examination i.e October-2018 in Kashmir Division/Winter Zones areas of Jammu Division and March-2019 in Summer Zone areas of Jammu Division

Scholarship: One Thousand scholarships will be awarded and the amount shall be:

a) Rs.1250/- per month for Class-XI to XII.

b) Rs.2000/- per month for undergraduates & post graduates, and

c) for Ph.D. shall be fixed in accordance with UGC norms.

General Instruction

- 1. Use Legal (8.5" x 14") size paper for taking print of the Application Form
- 2. This application form is meant for the students appearing at the State Level NTS examination 2018-19.
- 3. The Candidate/Principal of the School must confirm the last date for submission of Application Form and where to submit it, from the State Liaison Officer? Nodal Officers JKBOSE Jammu/Srinagar. No. application should be sent to NCERT.
- 4. The candidate/Principal must deposit the prescribed application fee in the JK Banks Account No:- 0547010100000002

 Branch:- BOSE IFS code:- JAKAOEXAMBR along with the application form in favour of Liaison Officer NTSE, (preferably through J&K Bank)
- 5. The candidate/Principal should leave the 4-digit Centre code blank, to be filled by the liaison Officer/Nodal Officers JKBOSE.
- 6. Incomplete /wrongly filled in application forms are liable to be rejected.
- 7. Applicants are requested to refer/consult the application form, published by the JKBOSE for caste category reservation. Some options of Caste Category (Like OC, Other 1 and other 2), given in the form are applicable for the State/UT only. No reservation will be given against these categories by the NCERT in the national level examination.
- 8. NCERT is not responsible, if any other item, which is not given in the common application form, has been included by the candidate.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE (FOR THE STUDENTS STUDYING IN CLASS X)

- 1. Make Sure that the Admit card is not detached from the application from. Admit card will be sent to the Superintendent of the examination centre after allotting the Roll Numbers. Candidate can collect the Admit card from the J&K BOSE Jammu/Srinagar at least one week before the examination.
- 2. Reach the examination centre at least half an hour before the commencement of the examination; and occupy the seat that bears your Roll Number.
- 3. DO NOT take mobile phones, calculator, Mathematical or Physical table or any other kind of ready beckoner to the examination hall.
- 4. The examination will be conducted in two sessions on the same day.
- 5. You have to take the examination as per details given below:
 - Mental Ability Test (MAT)
 - Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)
