SCHOLARSHIP NOTIFICATION

National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) for 2020-21: Inviting applications from Class 10th Students

All the students studying in Class 10th in **recognized Schools affiliated with JKBOSE or CBSE /Kendriya/Navodya Vidyalaya or other Schools located in UT of J&K and UT of Ladakh** are eligible to appear for Stage-I examination of National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) Session 2020-21 to be conducted by the Jammu and Kashmir Board of School Education scheduled on **27th December, 2020 (Sunday)**.

Eligibility:- Applicant must have secured 60% marks (5% relaxation for ST/SC category) in class 9th and due for appearing in ensuing Class 10th Annual Examination i.e. November 2020 in Kashmir Division/Winter Zone areas of Jammu Division, UT of Ladakh and March 2021 in Summer Zone areas of Jammu Division. Students registered under Open Distance Learning (ODL) are also eligible for the Scholarship. Students should be below the age of 18 years (as on 1st July 2020). **There will be no domicile restriction.**

Selection :- Stage –I, selection will be done by Jammu and Kashmir Board of School Education and those who are selected/ recommended from Stage –I examination, will be eligible for Stage-II (National Level) examination to be conducted by NCERT on **13th June, 2021**.

Scholarship: About two thousand scholarships are awarded for different stages of education as shown below across the Country:-

- Scholarship of Rs.1250/- per month for Class-XI to XII.
- Scholarship of Rs.2000/- per month for undergraduates & post graduates.
- Amount of Scholarship for Ph.D shall be fixed in accordance with UGC norms.

Examination: The pattern of written examination will be as follows:

**Instructions for the Candidates/ Principal of Schools for filling up the Application Form for State Level National Talent Search Examination, 2020-21
(For the Students Studying in Class X)**

General Instruction

1. Use Legal (8.5" x 14") size paper for taking print of the Application Form
2. This application form is meant for the students appearing at the State Level NTS examination 2020-21.
3. The Candidate/Principal of the School must confirm the **last date for submission of Application Form and where to submit it, from the State Liaison Officer? Nodal Officers JKBOSE Jammu/Srinagar. No. application should be sent to NCERT.**
4. The candidate/Principal must deposit the prescribed application fee of Rs 190/- through Pay-in Slip (Preferably from J&K Bank) into CD A/C No. 0547010100000002, lying at JK Bank, Branch JKBOSE Bemina, Srinagar, IFSC Code JAKA0EXAMBR in favour of Liaison Officer NTSE or in the form of Demand draft in favour of Liaison Officer NTSE, payable at RCC Srinagar(Draft should be preferably through J&K Bank .
5. The candidate/Principal should leave the 4-digit Centre code blank, to be filled by the liaison Officer/Nodal Officers JKBOSE.
6. Incomplete /wrongly filled in application forms are liable to be rejected.
7. Applicants are requested to refer/consult the application form, published by the JKBOSE for caste category reservation. Some options of Caste Category (Like OC, Other 1 and other 2), given in the form are applicable for the State/UT only. No reservation will be given against these categories by the NCERT in the national level examination.
8. NCERT is not responsible, if any other item, which is not given in the common application form, has been included by the candidate.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

(FOR THE STUDENTS STUDYING IN CLASS X)

1. Make Sure that the Admit card is not detached from the application form. Admit card will be sent to the Superintendent of the examination centre after allotting the Roll Numbers. Candidate can collect the Admit card from the J&K BOSE Jammu/Srinagar **at least one week** before the examination.
2. Reach the examination centre at least half an hour before the commencement of the examination; and occupy the seat that bears your Roll Number.
3. DO NOT take mobile phones, calculator, Mathematical or Physical table or any other kind of ready reckoner to the examination hall.
4. The examination will be conducted in two sessions on the same day.
5. You have to take the examination as per details given below:
 - Mental Ability Test (MAT)
 - Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)

9. Record your answer-using Ball Point Pen only. You have to indicate your answer on the answer sheet as advised.
10. During the examination follow the instructions of the Invigilator strictly.
11. Hand over your question booklet and answer sheets to the invigilator before you leave the Examination hall.
12. **Hand over the admission card to the invigilator before leaving the examination hall.**
