Section - B: Effective Writing Skills 20 Marks

- Q3. Five questions of one mark each will be asked out of eight Persian 5x1=5
- Q4. To write the meaning of five Persian words in Urdu/English/Hindi and use them in Persian sentences 5x1=5
- Q5. Arrangement of words in order to make five meaningful sentences 5
- Q6. Fill in the blanks with appropriate words of five sentences 5

Section - C: Applied Grammar 15 Marks

- Q7. Conjugation of two infinitives out of three with respect to past tense 6
- Q8. Conjugation of two infinitives out of three with respect to present tense 6
- Q9. Correction of three simple sentences 3

Section - D: Literature 55 Marks

- Q10. Translation of any three Persian passages into Urdu/English/Hindi out of four 3x6=18
- Q11. Translation of any two Urdu/English/Hindi passages into Persian out of three 2x6=12
- Q12. Translation of any two verses into Urdu/English/Hindi (Do any two out of three parts) 2x4=8
- Q13. Translation and explanation with reference to context of two verses into Urdu/English/Hindi (Do any two out of three parts) 2x6=12
- Q14. One objective type question consisting of 5 MCQs based on presented syllabus 5x1=5
